Archive Discussions:

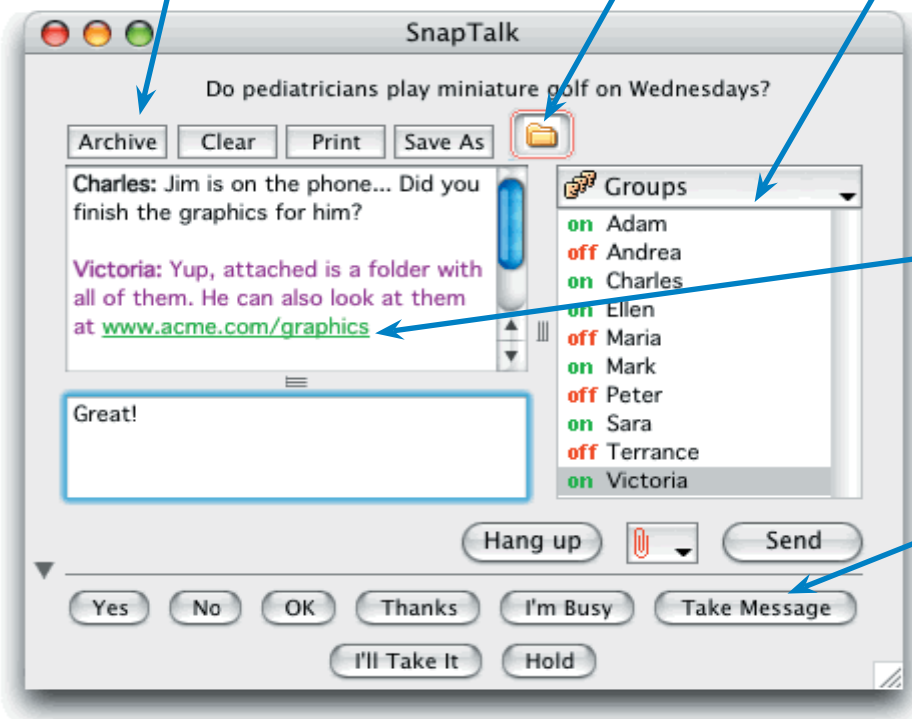
After you hang up save conversation in the archive log. Add or refer to files at a later date.
